

Part – A

The Centenary of Vande Mataram was celebrated on Sept 7, 2006. The noted speaker Prof. P.M.Galgali addressed our students.

Kendra Sahitya Academy, South Zone, Bangalore in association with our college and Sangamehwer Mahila Mandal organized a literary function ‘Sahitya Vedike’ on 12-8-2006. Eminent literatures and poets of this region took part in this programme.

Teachers' Day and Hyderabad Karnataka Liberation Day were observed on 5th Sept and 17th Sept 2006 respectively.

On 2nd Oct. 2006 Gandhi Jayanti was celebrated and Sarva Dharma Prarthana and a special lecture were the highlights.

On 6th Oct. 2006 Zilla Kannada Sahitya Parishat organized the special programme in celebration of Suvarna Karnataka and Dr. Ishwarayya Math delivered special lecture. After the function Maha Parinirvana Day of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar was observed and self composed poem recitation competition for students on the theme Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar was held.

With the support from UGC extension activities Karnataka Sahitya Academy and our college the music department made a novel attempt of composing the poems prescribed in the university text books, preparing notes on the poet and the poem and presenting them in different colleges of our district. This programme was taken-up from 11-11-2006 to 18-11-2006.

The construction work of auditorium with UGC assistance under 10th plan building grant was completed this year. On 1st, 2nd and 3rd Dec. 2006 our college hosted Gulbarga University Inter Collegiate Athletic Meet Miss Sneha Ravindra of B.Sc. First year won individual championship in field events in women section. Mr. Rajkumar Shinde bagged Bronze medal in hammer throw.

The District administration shouldered the responsibility of hosting 'Pratibha Youvajanatosva' - a mega event in this region. This programme was held on 10th and 11th Feb. 2007 was a great success. Our students bagged the highest points in all the activities and adjudged as the overall championship of 'Pratibha 2007'. The district administration inaugurated a website named 'Pragati' for Consultancy and Career Guidance Services on 11th Feb. 2007.

Dr. Shrikant Ekhelikar assisted our students in preparing a science model 'Computer as a tool in science education';. This model presented in the science

exhibition held at L.V.D. College Raichur on 19th and 20th Feb., 2007. won the appreciation of many and a prize.

Infosys Bangalore conducted campus selection interview for final year students of our college on 5-3-2007, and 4 students of our college were selected.

34 students of our college were declared successful in the Vachana Kammata Examination of Basava Kendra Mrugha muth, Chitradurg. Vice chancellor Dr. B.G. Moolimani inaugurated the National Science Day celebration of Noble Lauret Sir C.V. Raman on 28th Feb. 2006. On the eve of National Science Day 4 students including one from our college delivered lecture on 'Need for Modern Technology and Sir C.V.Raman',

Karnataka Sahitya Academy Bangalore in association with our college organized a workshop on 'The life and literature of Late Sri Rajpurohit'. It was a day long programme on 5th March 2007.

A UGC sponsored National Seminar on "Teaching-Learning- Languages and literature " was organized by our college on 30th and 31st March 2007. This seminar was attended by 65 language teachers from all parts.

Throughout the year various cultural and sports competitions were organized for the students of all faculties. The students of our college participated in such competition organized in and around Gulbarga and brought laurels to themselves and to the institution.

The year 2006-07 was an year of hectic activities. The announcement of NAAC to mark the year 2006 as an year students participation in quality assurance motivated us to host two mega events. 1) The Pratibha Utsav of District Administration and 2) 26th Inter Collage Athletic Meet of Gulbarga University, Gulbarga.

It was an Herculean task to standup expectation of 500 participating students in each event and a good number of officials from other colleges and cities of our university jurisdiction. Besides these two mega events the regular activities of NSS and Sports,

CGC -NWF, women's wing, hobby club were taken-up with added enthusiasm. The college has left no stone unturned in making the academic year 2006-07 a year of student participation.

PART – B

1) Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution :

a) This year being the year of students participation in quality assurance

The following activities were conducted.

- 1) Student – oriented, student monitored competitions and seminars.
- 2) A workshop to guide the students regarding the regulations of newly introduced semester system.
- 3) Deputed two students – 1) Sri Shankar I.V. of B.Sc.Third year and 2) Sri Mithun Kolhapur of B.Com.Third year to participate in a State Level Conference on 'Students' Role in Quality Enhancement' organized by J.S.S. College, Hubli.
- 4) One day Picnics, tours, art gallery visits, library visits were taken up for the benefit of the students.

b) Student Progression :

- 1) Remedial classes in chosen subjects were conducted for the benefit economically, socially and academically weaker students.
- 2) The mentoring scheme started in the previous year has many takers this year. Gradually the number of students participating in this programme is increasing.
- 3) Career Guidance and Counselling Cell is taking up activities to create general awareness and enhance the job prospects of our students.
- 4) Sports Department is mooting up a new idea of conducting intra institutional sports competitions.
- 5) Extra efforts are being taken-up to sensitize and synthesize the approach of students towards semester system.

2) New Academic Programme initiated :

Gulbarga University adopted semester system to all its undergraduate courses from the academic year 2006-07. The shift from age old annual system to newly adopted semester system has made us to take up the following programmes.

1) A study circle involving people from all the departments was formed to acquaint with the new rules and regulations of the semester system.

2) An inclusive workshop for students to ask any doubt on semester system was conducted on 21-9-2006. Our staff answered all the queries and doubts of the students.

3) Innovations in curricular design and transaction :

Any change needs acceptance from all the stakeholders concerned. Acceptance comes from better understanding. To take-up the teething problems of semester system a grievance redressal committee is setup by the Gulbarga University in each faculty. Our principal Dr. Swamirao Kulkarni and Prof. Hemant Kumar Kolhapure are in these committees. Dr. Srikant Ekhelikar, Dr. Suresh D. Heroor, Prof. V.T.Kukanur, Smt Sunanda V. Kulkarni were involved in semester syllabus framing in their respective subjects.

4) Inter-disciplinary programmes started:

Our university was kind enough to introduce computers and quantitative techniques in commerce faculty. Communication skills in English is introduced for all the faculties of third and fourth semesters. On the guidance of UGC our university has initiated the teaching of interdisciplinary subjects like Indian Constitution and Environmental Science for fourth semester students of all faculties. These are the innovations and inter-disciplinary programmes introduced in the curriculum. Interdisciplinary activities taken up by the college are 1) Hobby courses are opened for commerce and science students in Fine Arts. 2) On an experimental basis students are involved from all faculties in library assistance and management. 3) Sangeeta Shibiras in summer are conducted by our music UG and PG departments for the benefit of music learners and freshers.

5) Examination reforms implemented :

The academic council of our society is concentrating the academically weaker students. A subject wise analysis of the results is thoroughly taken-up. The subjects in which a sizeable number of students have not performed well are being made to take special coaching classes. This is expected to yield better results.

As per the requirements of the semester system, two internal tests in each subjects are conducted in every semester. The results in the form of marks are displayed on the college notice board. Absenteeism in these tests is seriously dealt with.

An examination of extra curricular activities (ECA) also forms the part of curriculum. Hence an ECA committee headed by Principal involving NSS officer, Sports Director, CGC co-ordinator and faculty heads is formed to assess the reports submitted by the students. Complete transparency is maintained in the allocation of marks

7) Initiative towards faculty development programme :

Almost all the teachers coming under grant-in-aid and UGC seats were required to fulfill the service conditions in respect of orientation and refresher course .The college with the assistance of UGC is encouraging all the teachers to participate and present paper in their respective subjects at national and inter national workshops and conferences.

The staff Association takes active part in inviting the authorities on different subjects to address our teachers. The society has permitted our teachers to improve their qualifications without disturbing the academic atmosphere in our college.

23) Numbers of Courses for which Students assessment of Teachers is introduced and the action taken on Student Feed-back.

Student assessment of teachers is introduced in a three tier model.

1) A suggestion box is kept in the Library premises and every student has a right to express his views regarding any matter connected to the college. At the end of every term the box is opened in the presence of Principal and faculty Heads. The suggestions are discussed and the important ones are brought to the notice of the concerned staff in the staff meeting.

2) Every lecturer is asked to collect feed back from his students and bring it to the notice of the Head of the Department.

3) Principal pays visits to the class rooms on a random basis and speaks to the students regarding the issues confronting them.

4) The students do express suggestions for improvement in welcome and farewell functions and in mentoring sessions.

25) Computerization of Administration and the process of Admissions and Examinations, Results and all other works.

Single window system process is initiated for the benefit of the students. Class wise collection of examination fees is practiced during the peak days to avoid the rush and save time of the students. Administration, admission, examination works and issue of certificates are partly computerized and automated.

26) Increase in infrastructure facilities:

A major work of construction is taken up to add a new spacious Principal chamber, Staff Room, a Computer Center and a Lecture Hall.

The auditorium built under the Xth plan UGC grants is furnished with the required facilities.

27) Technology-up gradation:

Library software up gradation from the existing 3.7 version to new version 4.2.23.

Computer systems were upgraded and new versions of software were added. Broad band facility from BSNL for internet accessing was provided from the central computer center.

A well equipped Audio-Visual Hall and Computer Lab has been established in the College with the help of UGC grants and adopted Micro-teaching methods for all disciplines. The outcome of this method found very encouraging.

Established “Internet Browsing Centre” to provide Internet Browsing facility to students and staff at a minimum cost. A proper training has been given to them by conducting “Internet Browsing Workshop”.

Apart from the above, the College provided Xerox and Fax facility for the students and Staff at a minimum cost.

Computer center is equipped with Broad Band internet facility. The College Established “Internet Browsing Center” to provide Internet Resource and Browsing facility for students and the staff at a minimum cost.
